

Reopening Plan for Sunday, June 7

May 31, 2020

Cedar Creek Bible Church Family:

Our deacons met today and decided to begin holding church services Sunday, June 7. We will hold a Sunday morning service at 11:00, a Sunday evening service at 6:00, and a Wednesday evening service at 7:00. We will not have a Sunday School hour, and we will not have any Children's Church classes for now. We will not staff a nursery at this time.

The CDC, in their Interim Guidelines for Communities of Faith, recommends the wearing of cloth face coverings when social distancing is difficult. We trust our people to act responsibly regarding masks. Please do not let the "mask / no mask" debate impair the unity of this local church.

CCBC will promote social distancing by roping off every other pew. There will not be a greeter handing out bulletins. We will place bulletins and prayer prompters on the pews before the service.

We will not pass offering plates during the morning service. For now, there will be offering plates available as you exit the auditorium after the morning service.

There will be congregational singing at CCBC. There will not be a choir or a Sunday morning band for now.

We will have abundant sources of hand sanitizer available, and strongly encourage that you continue to practice good hand washing habits.

We are committed to thoroughly cleaning high-contact surfaces between all services. We will remove hymnbooks and church Bibles from the pews.

Please be patient with us. We are attempting to watch out for the congregation's health—spiritual and physical. The CCBC deacons will meet again in two weeks to assess how we need to further adapt our practices to this fast-changing situation.

If you don't feel comfortable attending currently, please do not be afraid that we will judge you. Only you can understand your particular fears, concerns, and needs. If you think you may be sick, please stay home.

We, eleven deacons at CCBC, welcome your comments and questions. We love you, and are eager to see how God brings glory to Himself in the weeks and months to come.
